# How long do we store personal data

Bureau RMC does not store your data for longer than is strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which your data is collected. We use the following retention periods for the following (categories) of personal data:

## Sharing of personal data with third parties

Bureau RMC only provides to third parties if this is necessary for the implementation of our agreement with you, or to comply with a legal obligation.

#### Cookies, or similar techniques, that we use

Bureau RMC uses functional, analytical, and tracking cookies. A cookie is a small text file that is stored in the browser of your computer, tablet, or smartphone when you first visit this website. Bureau RMC uses cookies with solely technical functionality. These ensure that the website works properly and that, for example, your preferred settings are remembered. These cookies are also used to make the website work properly and to optimize it. We also make use of cookies that track your surfing behavior so that we can offer customized content and advertisements.

We inform you about these cookies and ask your permission to use them during your first visit to our website.

You can opt-out of cookies by setting your internet browser so that it no longer stores cookies. Also, you can delete all the information that was previously saved via the settings of your browser. #### Access, changes or removal of your data

You have the right to view, change, or remove your data. You can do this yourself via the personal settings of your account (via the link at the bottom of each newsletter). This means that you can submit a request to us to send the personal data that our computer files contain about you, to either you or another organization specified by you.

To ensure that <u>you</u> made the request for access, we ask you to send a copy of your proof of identity with the request. Make sure to black out your passport photo, the MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip with numbers at the bottom of the passport), the passport number and citizen service number (BSN) in this copy. This is to protect your privacy. Bureau RMC will respond to your request as quickly as possible, but in any case within four weeks.

Bureau RMC would also like to point out that you have the option to file a complaint with the national data protection authority, the Dutch Data Protection Authority.
